Secondary Track and Field State Representation

Reminder to all School Sport Coordinators to share with your talented Track and Field students, especially the Year 7s turning 13 who won't be aware – that the 2019 Australian All Schools Track and Field Championship is the representative pathway event for Secondary students, it is conducted by Athletics Australia not School Sport Australia, and therefore SSACT does not select nor organise the team to compete at the Championships from the 6 – 8 December in Perth.

The 13&O ACT Championships conducts is part of the selection process for Athletics ACT as well as two of their High Noon events for the events not within the SSACT Program; Sprint Hurdles, 3km run, Steeplechase, Pole Vault, hammer throw, 1500m walk, 3km walk, and long hurdles.

Students wishing to be considered for selection in the events listed above need to enter one or both of the 2 High Noon events on the 1 and 22 September – please refer to the SSACT website Track and Field page for High Noon event and (free) entry details as well as the AACT Selection Policy to share with your students.
